### 1 April (online day), 4-8 April (in-person programme in Vác)

The aim of the programme is to encourage students' engagement in intercultural dialogue, promoting cultural awareness through the sharing of cultural values, professional knowledge, and experience while developing critical thinking, communication, creativity, and collaboration.

The short-term blended intensive programme consists of a five-day workshop with physical presence in Vác (4-8 April) preceded by a day of virtual learning (1 April). The colourful and interactive programme focuses on the theme of *Intercultural Dialogue through Stories*.

- Learn to communicate and collaborate effectively with others in preparing group projects: What do you take home from the programme?

Promotion of networking among students through group work aimed at the preparation of cooperative projects

- to develop students' skills, competencies, and various types of intelligence in expressing their own cultural identities
- to better understand and appreciate the cultural identity of others
